# Initiative for Responsible Approach to Artificial Intelligence

The big question from Day 1 after we create Artificial Intelligence is what kind of being it will be and in whose hands it will end up. It is equally important that mankind does not lose control of AI. Therefore, AI should be regulated before it is created because once AI comes by it will be too late.

## 1. Establish International Artificial Intelligence Agency (IAIA)
